

## **BCRD DAY CAMP SPECIALTY ACTIVITIES**



### **BIKING TRIPS •**

Campers will need to bring their own bike if they are interested in biking. Biking destinations include Jimmy's Garden, Quigley Canyon, Toe of the Hill Trail, Heagle Park, Hop Porter Park. All biking trips are well supervised and utilize safe routes to parks and schools. A bike safety-training course will be offered for campers interested in biking. Campers wishing to bike must wear a helmet.

### **NEW – PUMP PARK •**

Located adjacent to the Aquatic Center, the BCRD Pump Park is a BMX style track with berms, dips and rollers. A beginner track will be installed this year for the younger and/or less experienced rider. A bigger track is available for youth who have proficient skills. Helmets are required and a skills course will be taught to new riders.

### **CLIMBING •**

Campers are encouraged to bring their own harness and shoes if they have them. Campers will be belayed by trained counselors and staff, and will adhere to the strict rules at the climbing wall.

### **ARCHERY •**

Campers will be taught the fundamentals of archery and will learn all of the safety techniques necessary for a successful archery experience. Campers will work to improve their accuracy at progressively longer distances.

### **GARDENING •**

Campers will have an opportunity to learn about gardening in a hands-on fashion. A kid's garden will be located in the courtyard behind the HUB for growing and maintaining a variety of vegetables. Campers will also have an opportunity to harvest and eat their crops. Guidance will be provided by a Sawtooth Botanical Garden volunteer.

### **TENNIS •**

Campers interested in tennis will have a great opportunity to learn this life long activity. The curriculum for the program is developed by the US Tennis Association and will feature QuikStart Tennis techniques which is geared towards kids in a fun, fast paced environment. We will use the courts adjacent to the Wood River High School

### **DRAMA •**

Campers will have the opportunity to perform in a play and take part in a camp-wide talent show. Drama is a great way for campers to build self-esteem and show off their talent. Performances will take place in the Community Campus auditorium.
