



FAQs

Who can play?

Winter Fun Bingo is designed with grade school children and their families in mind, but everyone is welcome to join in on the fun.

How do I complete the board?

Get to "BINGO!" by completing all of the activities in a row, column, or on a diagonal. There are a number of free squares to help you out on your journey.

What happens when I get bingo?

Where can I find all of these winter activities?

Here are some resources to get you started:

The **Wood River Trail** is a 32-kilometer, graded path that stretches from Ketchum to Bellevue. It's open for walking, skiing, snowshoeing, and fat biking in the winter, and is free to use.

Galena Lodge is a community-owned day lodge 22 miles north of Ketchum. It's surrounded by a network of Nordic ski and snowshoe trails, and gear rental is available on-site. A pass is required to ski or snowshoe, or, you can check it out on a Free Ski Day (Feb 20 & Mar 24, 2021).
